Additionally, the materials and design of the building are intended to be highly energy efficient. The goal is to have the new facility certified under the United States Green Building Council's (USGBC) Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED). This certification is given to structures that meet or exceed the USGBC's standards in energy efficiency and environmental design.
